■ Our Vision

At Treales, every child is a child of God, uniquely made and infinitely precious. We celebrate differences and provide the support each pupil needs to flourish academically, socially, emotionally, and spiritually.

■ Our Aims

- Welcome and value every child as part of God's family.
- Ensure pupils with SEND can **access a full, inclusive curriculum**.
- Work in **partnership with families**.
- Celebrate progress and success in all its forms.
- Create a caring, supportive environment rooted in **Christian values**.

■■ How We Support SEND Pupils

- **Early Identification** – spotting needs quickly so help can begin.
- **Graduated Approach** – Assess – Plan – Do – Review.
- **Tailored Support** – quality-first teaching, small group interventions, and 1:1 support where needed.
- **EQUALS Curriculum** – for pupils with more complex needs, focusing on:
 - My Communication (language, interaction, self-expression)
 - My Independence (daily living and life skills)
 - My Community (social awareness and participation)
 - Sensory Learning (tailored experiences for engagement)
- **Collaboration** – we work with families, health, and specialist services.
- **Transitions** – strong support when children move between classes or schools.

■■■ Who Helps?

- **SENDCO**: Mrs L Hill – coordinates SEND provision and is the first point of contact.
- **Class Teachers** – responsible for the progress of every child in their class.
- **Support Staff** – deliver interventions and provide additional support.
- **Governing Body** – ensures the school meets statutory duties.
