Welcome to Amber Class 2025 -26



In September your child will be in Amber class with Mrs Anderson and Ms Smart Here are a few bits of information to help you feel prepared. As always any questions please do ask.

PE Kit

Our PE days will be Tuesday and Thursday. Please ensure your children are wearing a plain white t-shirt and black shorts/jogqing bottoms.

Water bottles

Please can children bring in a named water bottle from home. They can keep it at school all week and they will be responsible for refilling it.

Homework and reading

Children will bring home an independent book to read. Please listen to your child every day and write in their diaries 3 times per week. An independent reading book will be just below their reading level so they practise fluency and reading out loud. If the book is too difficult, let me know by writing in their diary or speaking to me. Children must bring their book bags every day. Please check their book bags daily for letters or other information. It would be great if they could bring in an old top to wear over their uniform for art as we do not have aprons.

Doodle maths

Children are expected to complete Doodle maths at least 3x a week, daily is better! Completing their 5/6 a day (whatever stage they are on) every day has been proven to help. Which takes only about 2 minutes-depending on their questions. If you do not have your login, don't worry I will be sending them home in September.

Topic Information-September

Ships ahoy! The sea is fascinating! Why not take a trip to the coast? Visit the harbour, lifeboat station or beach and take plenty of interesting photographs. Over the year, we will ask children to bring in photographs of places they have visited so we can display them on our class maps. Remember to talk about where we live. What town do we live in?
