Term 2 Geography Topic Overview - Where Does Our Food Come From?

- Children learn that the food we eat comes from all around the world and explore where different breakfast foods originate.
- Children discover how temperate climate zones, like Kansas in the USA, are used to grow and transport crops such as wheat.
- Children find out how tropical climates are ideal for growing foods like bananas and learn about the importance of fair trade.
- Children explore how tropical biomes, such as those in Indonesia, are changed for rice farming and the effects of deforestation.
- Children learn how the warm, dry conditions of Mediterranean climates allow for the production of foods like olives and grapes.
- Children investigate how the UK's climate and land are used to grow crops and raise animals for food.
- Children explore global food trade links and how foods from around the world are imported and sold in the UK.
