- How would Roman people have bought their clothes and food? Research and draw a Roman coin.
- Roman centurions had a very distinct look. Draw or paint a picture of a Roman centurion, labelling the key parts of their look.
- Romans typically went to taverns for their hot food. Research the type of food they ate and create a menu for a Roman warrior. See if there are similarities or differences compared to the food we eat today.
- Julius Caesar was the most famous Roman Emperor. Using subheadings and a glossary, create a fact file about him.
- There were many things that the Romans brought to Britain. Research Roman inventions and tell us how they work and what they were used for.

- Write down a word related to the Romans for each letter of the alphabet. Then write a sentence explaining some of them. For example:

A - army

B - battle

C - centurion

- Choose the one thing that interests you the most about the Romans and create a song/poem or rap to explain it. Record/write down your composition.
- Draw or paint a scene from Roman times. E.g., a banquet, a chariot race or a Roman household.
- Imagine you are a Roman slave. Decide on your Roman name and write a diary entry describing your day.
- The Romans worshiped many gods. Research these gods and draw a picture of what you think your favourite would look like.
- Make your own Roman toga and dress up in it - we'd love to see the outfit!
