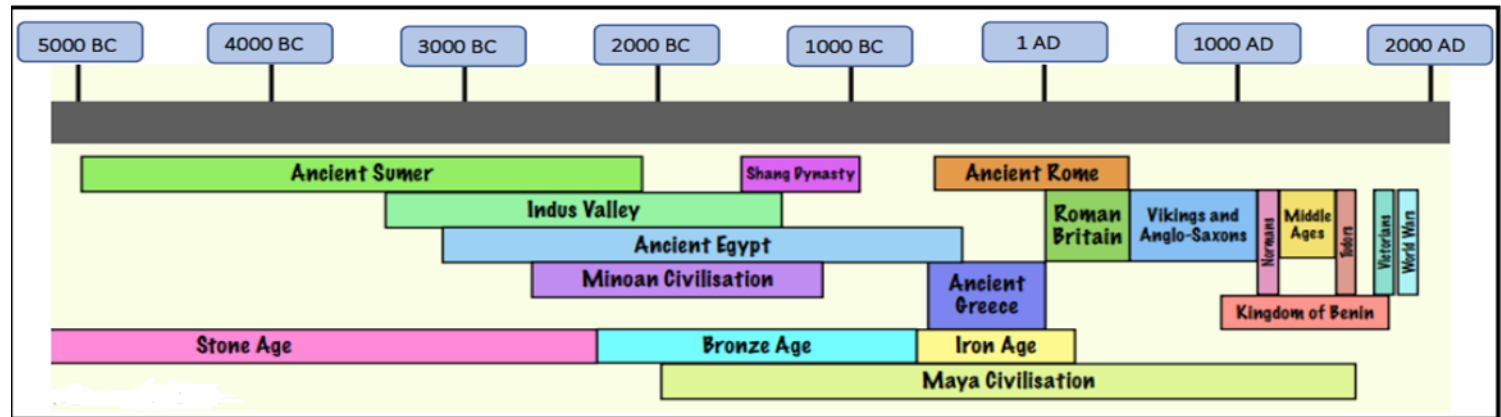
Sutton Hoo is an archaeological, burial ship site of an Anglo Saxon.

The Anglo-Saxons were not one group of people. They came from many different places.

The Anglo-Saxons conquered the Britons who were living in England and pushed them north. These were the Picts and Scots.

The Picts, Scots and Anglo Saxons would battle, constantly trying to gain more land and power from each other.

Their religion was mixed: Christianity and Paganism.
