

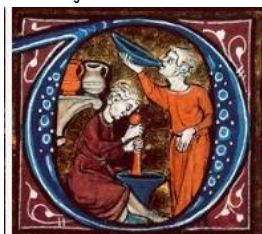
## Anglo Saxon Year 3/4 Homework—Spring Term

The Anglo Saxon grid below contains extra activities, ideally one homework every two weeks to be shared on a Monday.

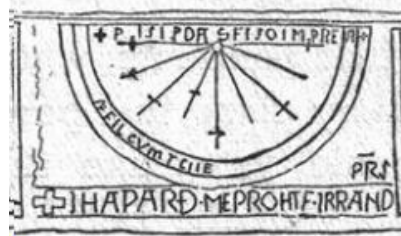
Find out about Anglo-Saxon medicine and how they cured some common ailments such as colds and headaches.

Recreate an object that was found at Sutton Hoo, or any other Anglo Saxon find. Could you write an information card to go with your artefact explaining what it is and why you think it was buried at Sutton Hoo or Mildenhall.



Research Anglo Saxon coins. Design a realistic Anglo-Saxon coin. Can you draw and label your design?



Research the foods that Anglo Saxons ate. Can you create a menu to show what would have been eaten on a regular day?



Find out about Anglo-Saxon law and order. Create a wanted poster for a Saxon criminal!
