Key Vocabulary	
Map	A drawing or picture that shows where places are. It helps you find directions and see where things are located.
Destination	The place you are going to on a journey. It is where you end up.
Travel	To go from one place to another, such as by car, train, plane, or on foot.



### Sticky knowledge

Summer is one of the four seasons and usually has warmer weather and longer days.

People travel to different places during the summer for rest, fun, or to visit family.

A **destination** is the place you are travelling to.

A **map** helps us locate places and plan journeys.

Holidays can take place in different environments (beach, countryside, city), and each has different features.
