 We really hope you'll pop along and support Ruby Class!

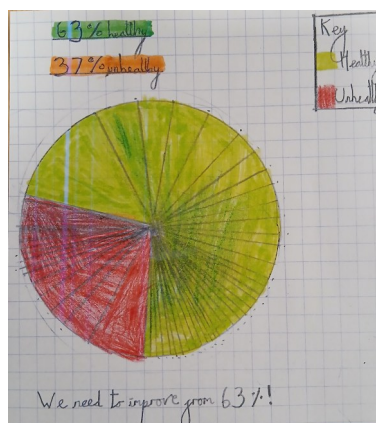


Uniform Sale:
