Stained-glass Workshop, Y6

Way back in March, some members of Year 6 took part in a Stained-Glass window workshop along with local artist Tracey Spiers. This was part of the development phase of St Laurence Church and its restoration plans.

The focus of this activity was the historic Angel Window, which had been removed due to subsidence and is awaiting repair and reinstatement. In the interim, a large-scale tissue paper interpretation was designed and created with Year 6 pupils from Stroud Valley Community Primary School.

The class attended two sessions across the day. The morning group completed the left-hand section of the window, including the four-leaf clover top panel and a Stroud Valley School motif. The afternoon group completed the right-hand section. Pupils worked in small groups of three, following a demonstration by local artist Peter Westley, carefully applying coloured tissue paper to create stained-glass effects.
