

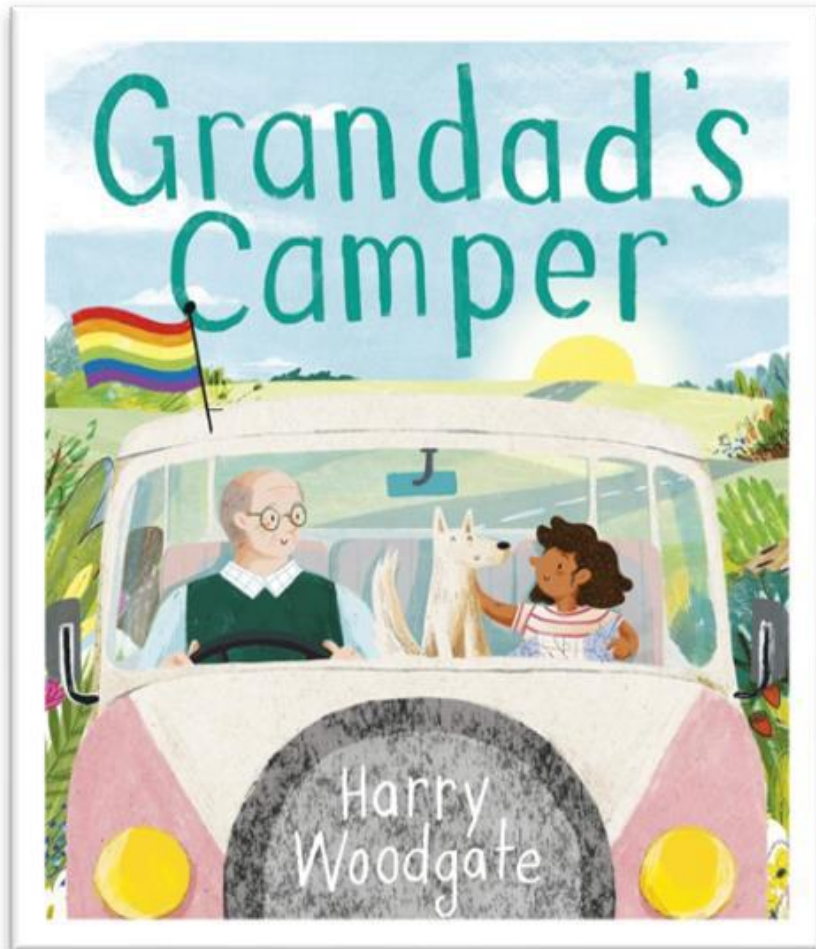
Year 2 Spring 1 - Grandad's Camper by Harry Woodgate
