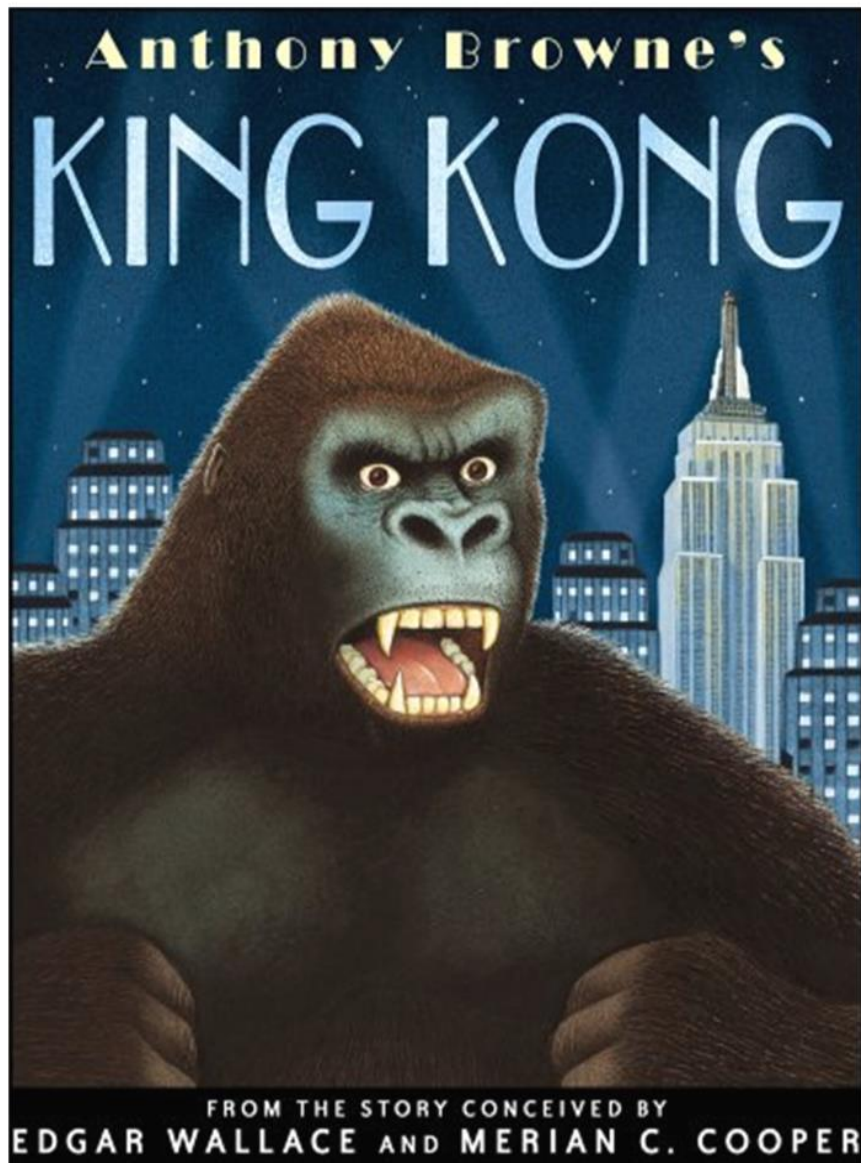


Year 6 Autumn 1 – King Kong by Anthony Browne
