Dinner Money & Tuck Shop

The cost of school meals for the week remains at £13.75 but if you wish to pay for the half term (3rd September to 23rd October), this would be £101.75. Payments for meals can now be paid for via your Arbor app (juniors only), if you have more than one child at our school, please ensure you top up their accounts individually by switching to the other child's account. Menus can be found on the website, school kitchen window and the school noticeboard.

Tuck Shop Prices: even though we have managed to keep our school meal prices the same this year, we have sadly had to increase the cost of our tuck shop items. Therefore, from September a slice of toast will cost 30p, crumpets 60p, bottles of water 60p and bacon or sausage barm (Friday only) will be £1. Tuck shop for the Infants will be on Tuesdays and Thursdays and Juniors will be Wednesdays and Fridays.

Huge thanks must go to Mrs. Appleton, our Catering Manager and her team for providing the children with excellent quality home made meals to satisfy every appetite.
