Our Learning This Week

Literacy: This week we will continue to learn our class story 'Lost and Found' exploring the meaning of key vocabulary within the text.

Maths: This week, children will learn about one more within 5. They will use role play and first, then, now story structures to explore adding one more. Children will learn to recognise that the next number they count is one more than the previous number.

Phonics: We will continue to introduce new sounds daily and focus on blending sounds together to make words.

Understanding the World: We will continue exploring the weather during different times of the year. We will explore the changes that happen during Autumn and look for signs of Autumn outside.
