



**Year 2**  
**Spring Term 1**  
**January - February 2026**

Science

This half term we will be learning about the changes in seasons. Exploring what happens to plants and animals during different seasons. We will also be looking at weather and how that relates to seasonal changes.

Physical Education

In PE we will be learning about striking and fielding games and target games. The children also have the opportunity to take part in a variety of after school clubs. Our PE days this term are Monday and Wednesday.

English

This term we will be reading Traction Man by Mini Grey. We will writing sentences and captions about the adventures he goes on. We will work towards being able to retell the story. Children will also continue with RWI.

Mathematics

Over the next half term we will be learning about numbers to 50, including addition and subtraction facts to 20. We will then explore length and height and weight and volume. We will carry out different activities to understand why and how we measure things.

Geography

We will be comparing our city, Liverpool, with our capital city, London. We exploring where we live on the map. We will also explore the different landmarks in the cities and compare the man-made and natural features.

Religious Studies - Come and See

This term our topic is Galilee to Jerusalem. In this branch, pupils will deepen their knowledge from Year One about who Jesus is and understand how he teaches about the nature of God through .parables and miracles.

P.S.H.E.

We are looking at 'Appreciation' and 'Gratitude' over the next few weeks. Children will identify experiences of gratitude for themselves, for experience and for others.

Computing

This half term children will develop their understanding of technology and how it can help them in their everyday lives. They will start to become familiar with the different components of a computer by developing their keyboard and mouse skills. we will also consider how to use technology responsibly.

Art and design technology

This term we will be painting in art, we will be exploring primary and secondary colours. We will be using nature and natural items to help create our artwork taking inspiration from artisits work.

Music

Our topics in music this term include 'Football; and 'Dawn' from sea interlude through these topics we will develop our listening and responding skills as well as create our chants.
