# Our Learning



## Seedlings

We have been learning to turn pages in books, build with blocks, explore musical instruments and the sounds they make, and understand that they can fill and empty containers in maths.



## Orchard

In Orchard, we have been learning about houses. The children extended their interest in their new construction resources. We have been learning about the features of houses and the children have enjoyed sharing their houses in photos with the class. We developed our physical skills outdoors, learning independence on our obstacle course and learning how to jump and land on two feet.



## Acorn

We have been learning how to use glue correctly, name colours and collage materials. We looked at pictures of our homes and named features of buildings.







## Willow

As part of our topic on buildings, we have been learning about castles and bridges. Some of our children enjoyed the theme so much, that we made crowns and shields, learning how to join and glue materials.
