Our Learning



Seedlings

We have been identifying and naming eggs. The children had lots of fun trying to find the hidden eggs. We have also been learning to name farm animals and the sounds they make. We have also been working on our printing skills creating a spring collage of flowers, rabbits and chicks.



Orchard

This week, we have been learning about Spring and the names of baby animals and the sounds they make. We have been getting creative, making chicks with paints and lambs with cotton wool and glue. We are also still enjoying our outdoor area and our obstacle courses and doing lots of building with different materials.

This week we have been learning that the season is called Spring, and that flowers and plants grow from a seed. We have also been learning the names of baby animals, naming lambs, chicks and ducklings. We even had a special visit from the chicks.
