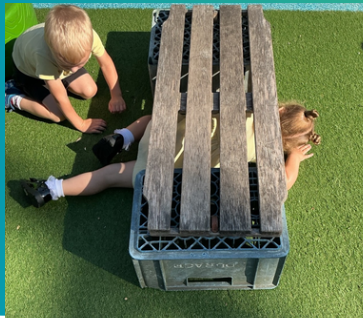
Seedlings
