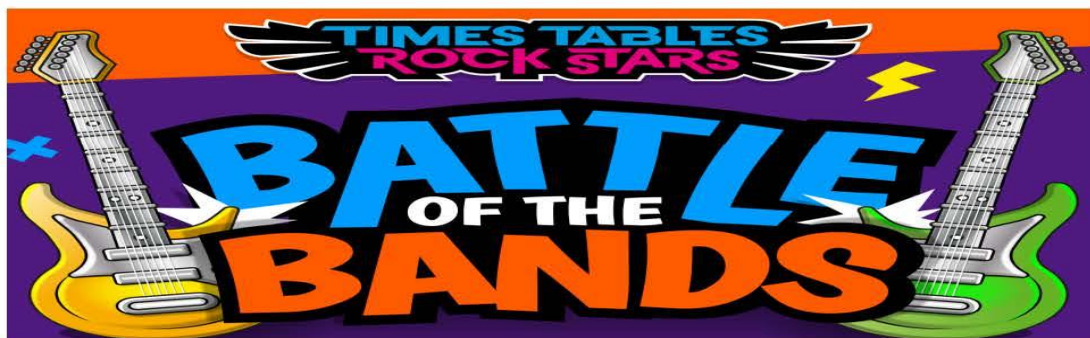

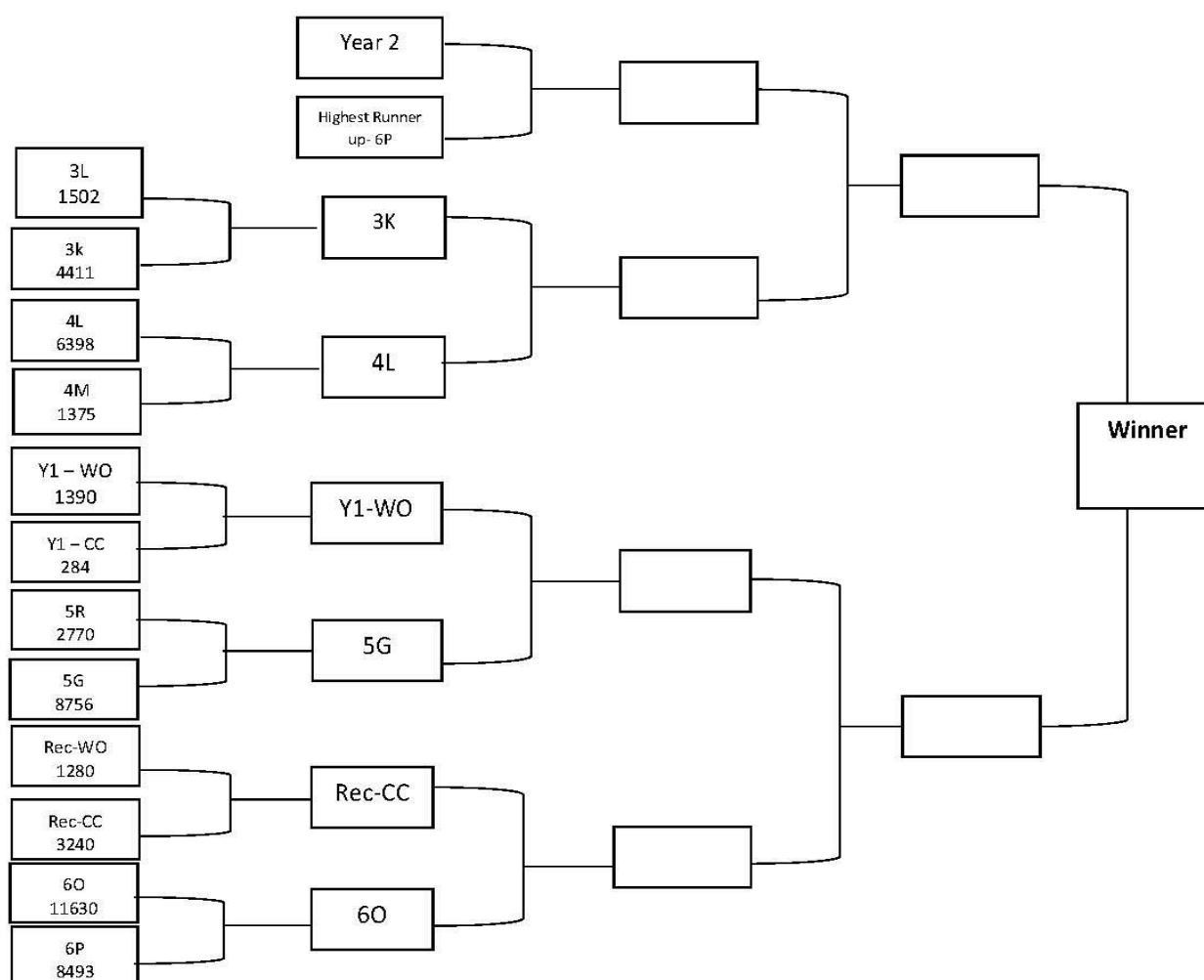
Hale Prep TTRS and Numbots Tournament (Autumn 2025 Edition)
