SAFETY ONLINE

We are aware that some children enjoy playing Roblox and other online games, which can be fun and creative. As with many online platforms, it does include interaction with other users, so children may be exposed to inappropriate content or contacted by people they do not know if parental controls are not in place. If you have not already done so, we would advise you to check your child's account and ensure appropriate privacy settings and parental restrictions are activated, including limiting chat, messages, content access and in-game spending. We also encourage you to monitor screen time. It is strongly advisable that your child has at least an hour of free screen time before going to bed.
