DRAMA FUN CLUB PERFORMANCE

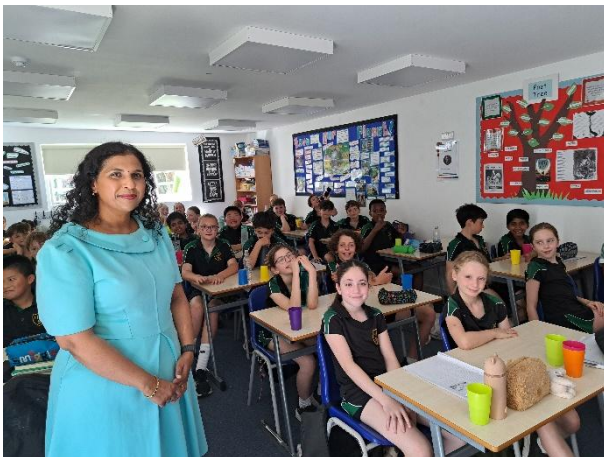
