Quick reminders:

1. **Names in kit-** Thank you to the overwhelming majority of parents who have put names in their child's kit-it really does make it easier for staff to return items that children have mislaid. If you have purchased any second-hand uniform, please ensure that you have replaced any previous name on the item of clothing with your child's name
2. The children in Years 2-6 should wear long black and green socks for their double lessons (Tuesday Years 2, 3 and 4) and Friday (Years 5 and 6).
3. White socks should be worn for single lessons. Reception and Year 1 should wear white socks at all times.
4. If your child wears earrings, they must either take them out for PE lessons or bring tape to cover them with.
5. If your child wears an item of jewellery for religious purposes, they must cover it for PE
