# What we already know...

We have birthday's to celebrate the date that we were born. We send cards, have parties and eat treats. At Christmas time we celebrate the day that Jesus was born.

## By the end of the topic we will be able to (EYFS DM)

#### <u>Understanding of the World:</u>

Recognise that people have different beliefs and celebrate in lots of different ways.

Comment on images of familiar situations in the past.

Compare and contrast characters from stories including figures from the

#### Expressive Arts and Design:

Listen attentively, move to and talk about music, expressing their feelings and responses.

Explore and engage in music making and dance, performing solo or in groups.

Make use of props and materials when role playing characters in narratives and stories.

#### **Mathematics:**

Count beyond 10.

Understand the 'one more than/one less than' relationship between consecutive numbers.

Select, rotate and manipulate shapes to develop spatial reasoning skills. Compare length, weight and capacity.

#### <u>Literacy:</u>

Blend sounds into words, so that they can read short words made up of known letter-sound correspondences.

Read and few common exception words.

Form lower case letters correctly.

Read some special friends that each represent 1 sound.

### Communication and Language:

Engage in story times.

Describe events in some detail.

Listen to and talk about stories to build familiarity and understanding. Use new vocabulary throughout the day.
