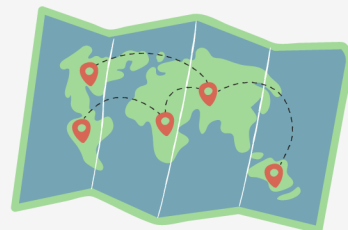

Time to Explore



What we already know...

Some past events from our own history. We have explored dinosaurs and different environments through our play based experiences. We have discussed our own past and the past of our families. We regularly use our class time line to refer back to recent past events in school. We know the days of the week and months of the year and can talk about events in our recent history. We have explored Spain and take part in Spanish language sessions. We know some facts about Africa and have compared it to where we live.

Understanding of the World:

Explore the natural world around us.
Draw information from a simple map.
Explain some similarities and differences between life in this country and life in other countries, drawing on knowledge from stories, non-fiction texts and maps.
Understand the past through settings, characters and events encountered in books read in class and story telling.
Personal, Social and Emotional Development:
Think about the perspectives of others.
Know and talk about the different factors that support our over all health and wellbeing:
Regular physical activity, healthy eating, toothbrushing, having a good sleep routine and being a safe pedestrian.

Literacy:

Demonstrate understanding of what has been read to us by retelling stories and narratives using our own words and new vocabulary.
Read words consistent with our phonic knowledge by sound blending.
Write simple words and sentences that can be read by others.

Mathematics:

Have a deep understating of number to 10, including the composition of each number.
Subitise (recognise quantities without counting) up to 5.
Verbally count beyond 20, recognising the pattern of the counting system.
Automatically recall number bonds for numbers 0-5 and some to 10.

Let's try this at home

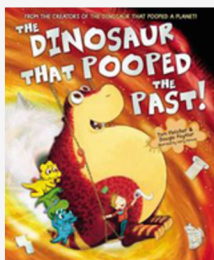
Talk about events that have happened in the past and the existence of dinosaurs.

Create simple maps of journeys you have taken and turn them into a treasure hunt.

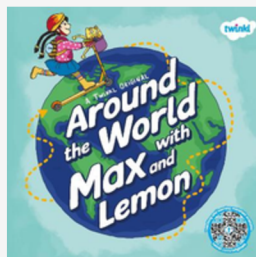
