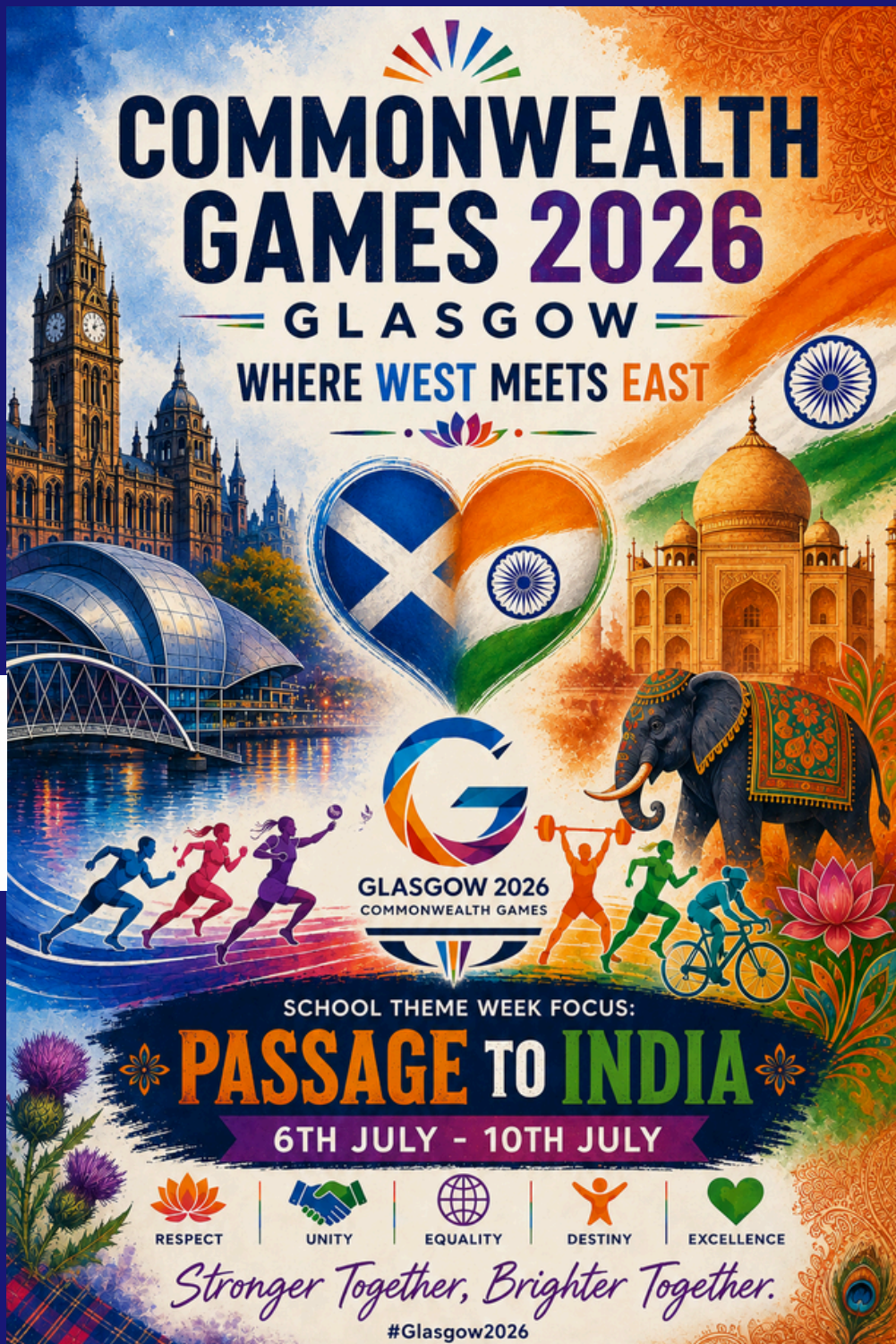
## It's a cracker!
