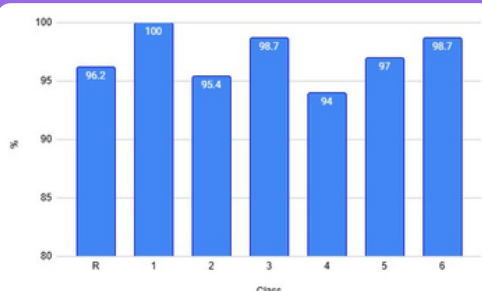
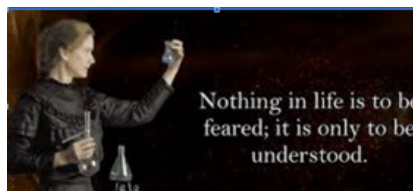

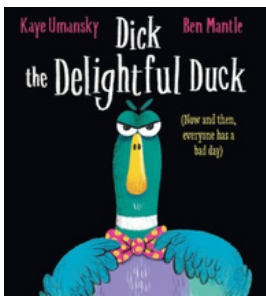
Assembly Focus of the Week
