


Assembly Focus of the Week: School Councillors 2025-2026

Forest School Area - Important Information

I'm excited to share that Mrs Bland is in the process of developing a new Forest School space. Forest School sessions will now take place on the grassed area located next to the car park. This will be a dedicated space which will provide wonderful outdoor learning experiences for our pupils. Mrs Bland has lots of planned projects to gradually add into this developing space including a mud kitchen and messy play space, an outdoor reading space, physical development zones for climbing and balancing, and I'm sure much more!

In order to protect this space, we kindly ask that parents do not allow children to access or play in the Forest School area during drop-off and pick-up times. This area is strictly out of bounds outside of supervised sessions. Additionally, please note that both the vehicle gate (Woodstock Avenue) and pedestrian gate (Thorn Grove) will be closed between 1:00pm and 3:00pm on Wednesday afternoons. This is to keep our car park vehicle-free to ensure pupil safety during our scheduled Forest School sessions. Thank you for your cooperation and support as we make the most of this exciting new learning opportunity!
