


Assembly Focus of the Week: Book Boxes

The children loved auditioning to be a badger showing their best barking and digging actions!






Harvest Donations

Year 3 Forest School

This half term, Team Farook have been the first class to enjoy our new Forest School space since it was set up over the summer by Mrs Bland. The children have engaged in a number of different activities over their first three sessions, including: creating a promise flag to represent their commitment to protecting our forest school site and the nature within it; making forest bouquets; competing in a "best nest contest"; tree-climbing; creating mess in the mud kitchen; and studying bugs and minibeasts. They have been involved in several creative tasks such as taking wax rubbings of flowers and trees, creating natural prints using a technique called "hapa zome", and using square lashing to construct their own frames for natural art. It has been a delight to see the children enjoying this new space and I am sure our other classes are eagerly anticipating their turn to get stuck in!
