Team Coelho had their first trip of the year, last Thursday. We all went to Cheadle Mosque as part of our RE work with Mr Cotterill, 'Who is a Muslim and what do they believe?' The morning was split into three sessions: What is pilgrimage? What are the different parts of the mosque and how do Muslims pray? What is the Arabic alphabet and how do Muslims show charity? We got to wear traditional dress for hajj, found our own initials in Arabic as well as how the imam calls people to prayer. The leaders of the sessions were very impressed with the knowledge and questions we shared and were very impressed with our level of respect and manners too. We have learned a lot and will be using it in our RE lesson this week.
