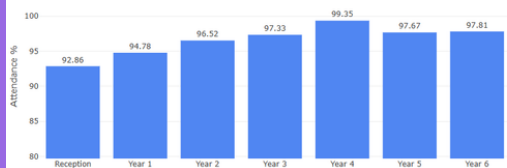

- Gain reassurance about what this exciting new chapter could mean for our school community

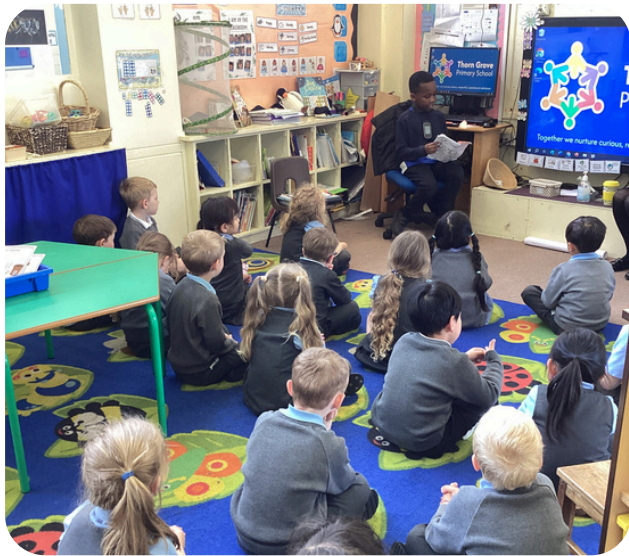
