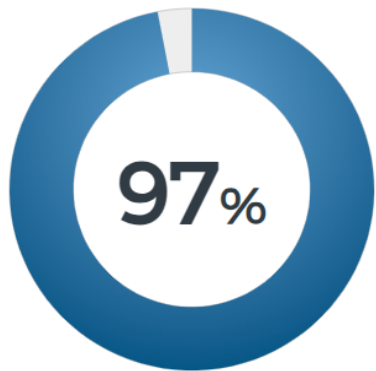


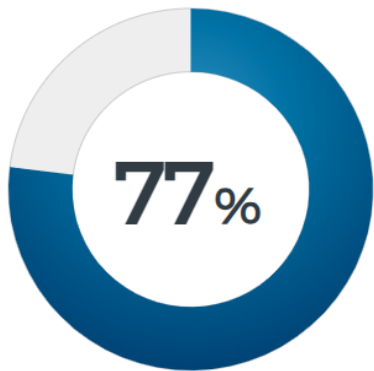

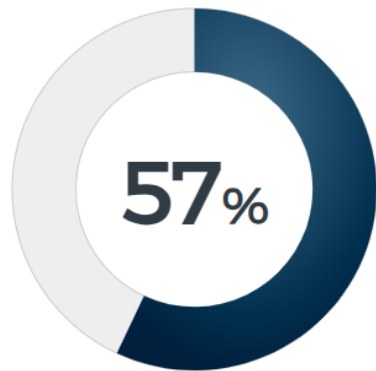
Swimming Outcomes for current Year 6 pupils
