Sticky facts to know and remember

- A moving vehicle needs an axle with wheels.
- The axle is a rod which goes through the centre of the wheel to make them turn.
- Movement can be made by fixing the wheels to the axle and allowing the axle to spin.
- A chassis is the framework which attaches the wheels to the body of the vehicle.
