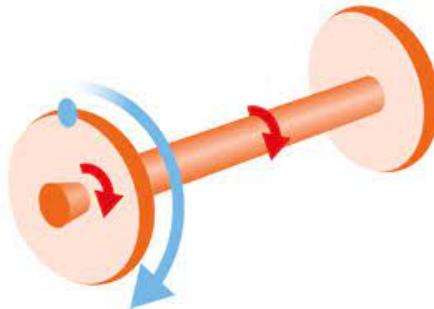
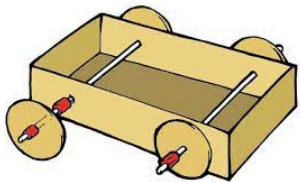


Sticky facts to know and remember
