- A county is a region (an area of a fixed boundary) of a country.
- Cheshire is the county in which we live.
- Cheshire, Merseyside, Greater Manchester, Cumbria, Lancashire are counties in the North West.
- A city is a large town that usually has a cathedral.
- Liverpool (Merseyside), Chester (Cheshire) and Manchester (Greater Manchester) are cities in the North West.
- A coast is the part of the land which meets the sea.
- Liverpool and Blackpool have a coastline.
- Physical coastal features include pebbles, sea, beaches, cliffs and caves.
- Human coastal features are lighthouses, harbours and defences.
- People travel between cities and towns on roads and motorways
- People like to visit coastal areas to go for walks and visit the beach.
