## English

Our quality texts are-

- Juniper Jupiter
- Little Red

Literacy: Explore song lyrics by listening to and talking about our favourite Disney songs. Discover our key text 'Juniper Jupiter' and write our own superhero story.

Reading: Engage in extended conversations about stories and learn new vocabulary.

Writing: Practise letter formation and write independently during play.

Phonics: Continue with daily Read Write Inc phonics lessons.

Phonics books and handwriting sheets will be sent home weekly.



## Personal, Social, Emotional Development

- Promote the self-selection of materials and resources so children can make their own plan.
- Talk about music, expressing their feelings and responses.



## Communication & Language

- Develop our listening skills and understand why listening is important.
- Learn rhymes, poems and songs. Practise the 'nursery rhyme of the week', both in class and at home.

## Physical Development

- Practise fine motor and gross motor skills both indoors and outdoors.
- Weekly PE sessions in the hall, building on fundamental movement skills.
