They work in partnership with Platform for Life, Capa First Response and Power 2. Each organisation offers support to ensure families receive the right help at the right time.

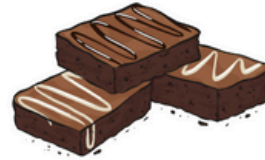

FUNDRAISING FOR KOALA NORTH WEST

We would like to share a fundraising initiative being led by one of our parents, Jessica Jump, inspired by the incredible work of the air ambulance service following a serious accident involving her son. Air ambulance teams provide lifesaving emergency care every day, yet many people are unaware that these services receive no government funding and rely entirely on charitable donations to continue their vital work.

In September, Teddy was involved in a road traffic collision and was airlifted to Alder Hey Children's Hospital, where he received urgent treatment. Thankfully, his injuries were not life-threatening, and he is continuing to make a good recovery.

Teddy's family is extremely grateful to all the emergency services who attended—especially the air ambulance crew, whose swift, professional care made an enormous difference at such a critical moment.

As a way of giving back, Teddy's mum has launched a fundraising effort to support the air ambulance service. Any donation, no matter how small, would be hugely appreciated and will help ensure this essential service can continue saving lives.
