EYFS	Children learn to make sense of their immediate world around them. Through experiences, including walks around the school and local area, their knowledge of the environment and world in which they live is increased. Pupils describe their environment using maps, observations and books. Pupils make links between life in this country and life in other countries including Spain (Spanish) and China (Chinese New Year). Through stories, non-fiction texts and rhymes, children will develop their vocabulary of language which links to geography.
