
5. Dialogue

- Focus: Relationship with other Christian traditions, religions, and worldviews.
- Promotes dialogue as essential for living faithfully in a pluralistic world.
- Rooted in love of neighbour and modelled on concentric circles (Christian denominations → Judaism → Islam → all humanity).

6. Encounter

- Focus: Study of other faiths and worldviews.
- Pupils study: other Christian denominations, Judaism, Islam, Dharmic religions, and nonreligious worldviews.
- Avoids comparative/relativistic approach; respects each tradition on its own terms.



During each school year, from EYFS to Year 6, there are six half-terms and, under the current RE directory, these periods of time are split into branches:

AUTUMN 2 – Prophecy & Promise
