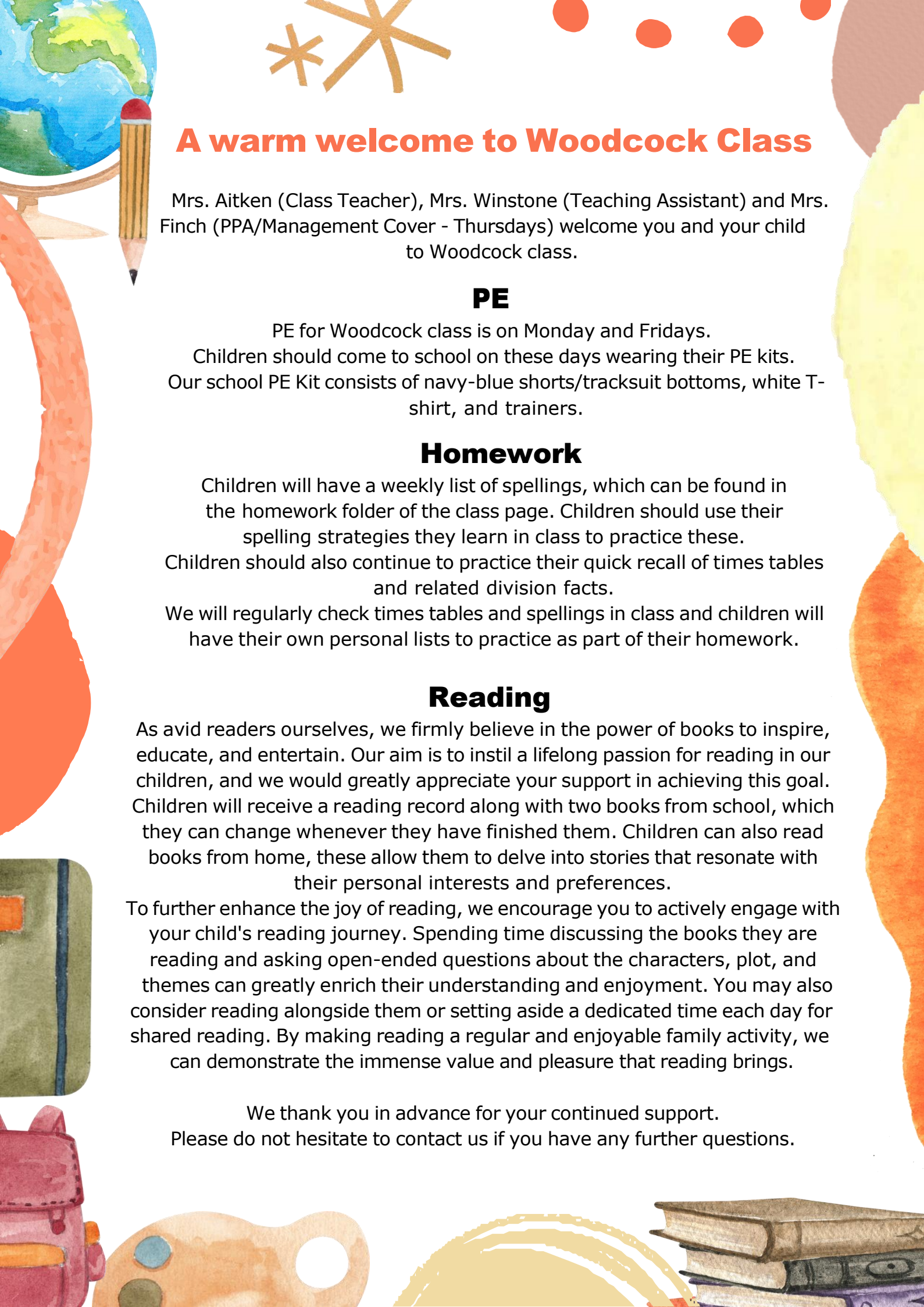




A warm welcome to Woodcock Class
