Literacy

Writing

Write some letters in their name.

Phonics

Recognise words with the same initial sound, such as money and mother.

Mathematics

Discuss routes and location (above, between, across.)
Compare sets of objects by looking - more and fewer.
Sequence events - First, Then, Next.

Recognise that a number of objects stay the same when rearranged.

Personal, Social and Emotional Development

Shows awareness of how their actions affect others.

Demonstrates confidence in group activities and discussions.

Expressive Arts and Design

Uses imaginative play to act out familiar experiences or stories.

Understanding the World

Shows care for living things and the environment (watering plants, tidying outdoors.)

Communication and Language

Introduce prepositions through play and through stories.

Can retell simple stories with prompts and visuals.

Physical Development

Shows good control when running, jumping, and climbing.

Uses scissors to cut around simple shapes.
