Elm Class

Maths

Comparing numbers to 100.
Say 1 more and 1 less than a number to 100.
Tell the time for o'clock and half past times.

How To Help

Practise counting in 2s to 20, in 5s to 50 and in 10s to 100. Start at different numbers. Count backwards if they are confident.

Make a clock with a paper plate. Talk about what the numbers and hands on a clock mean.

Writing

We will be reading lots of different books this term. We will be focusing on:

Writing sentences.

Using words that start with -un and words that end with -er and -est.

Begin to use exclamation and question marks.

How To Help

Orally say full sentences, count the words and then record.

Can they read back their sentences and spot any errors?

Reading

Your child will have a new reading book every week. They will practise it throughout the week with an adult in school.

How To Help

Read often with your child and encourage them to sound out words they don't know.

Ask them questions to recall what happened in the story or to recall facts.

Science

We will be learning about different types of animals and how to group classify them according to their structures and diets.

How To Help

Talk to your child about different types of animals and research if they are mammals, fish, amphibians, reptiles or birds. You could research what they eat too.

Geography

We will be recapping all the Geography knowledge we have learnt this year:

There are four countries in the UK.

The types of houses and human landmarks in Ellesmere Port.

How weather changes throughout the seasons.

How To Help

Look at maps together.

Go for a local area walk. What can they spot?

Keep a weather diary.

Computing

We will be learning how to be safe when we are playing games online.

How To Help

Talk to your child about how they can safeguard themselves online.

RE

We will be learning about what Muslims celebrate.

How To Help

Research Muslim celebrations. There are free Twinkl videos online. Libraries also have books about Islam.

DT

Making a fruit and vegetable snack.

How To Help

Practise naming fruits and vegetables.
Encourage your child to try different fruit and vegetables.

PE is on a Monday afternoon.

PSHE is all about rules and understanding why we have them.

Music is all about learning call and response activities.
