## Literacy

## Expressive Arts and Design

Begins to join in with familiar songs and rhymes  
Engages in simple pretend play using real objects (phones, cups, bags)

## Personal, Social and Emotional Development

Begins to understand simple routines and boundaries.

Starts to play alongside others, showing early interest in peers

## Understanding the World

Starts to ask simple questions such as "What's that?" or "Why?"

## Communication and Language

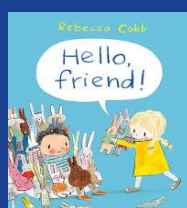
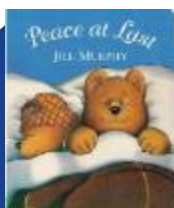
Follow simple instructions and routines.
