- Are aware of humour and jokes amongst pupils as they may be derogatory about stereotypes and should be challenged.
- Challenge negative attitudes.
- Use a range of resources which reflect the diversity of our students.
- Ensure resources are always non- sexist, non- racist and non- discriminatory.
- Adapt resources and incorporate differing learning styles when possible.
- When dividing the class into groups we ensure mixing genders, differing abilities, religious backgrounds and other differences within the cohort.
