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SEESAW:

All Seesaw codes can be found in the back of your child's reading diary if you are logged out at any time. To log back in, please open the Seesaw app and select "Scan QR Code."

Please note that the QR code cannot be scanned using your phone's camera alone - you will need to scan it directly through the Seesaw app.

REMINDERS:

PE Kit: Children should wear **black pumps** or **suitable trainers** (no laces, please, unless your child can confidently tie them independently). PE kit should also include **black shorts** or **leggings**, a **white T-shirt**, and a **Stanley cardigan/jumper**.

For safety reasons, **all earrings must be removed for PE**. If earrings are worn to school, they should be small studs only.

Please ensure your child brings a warm, waterproof **coat** with a hood to school every day. During colder weather, children may also bring **hats**, **scarves**, and **gloves**.
