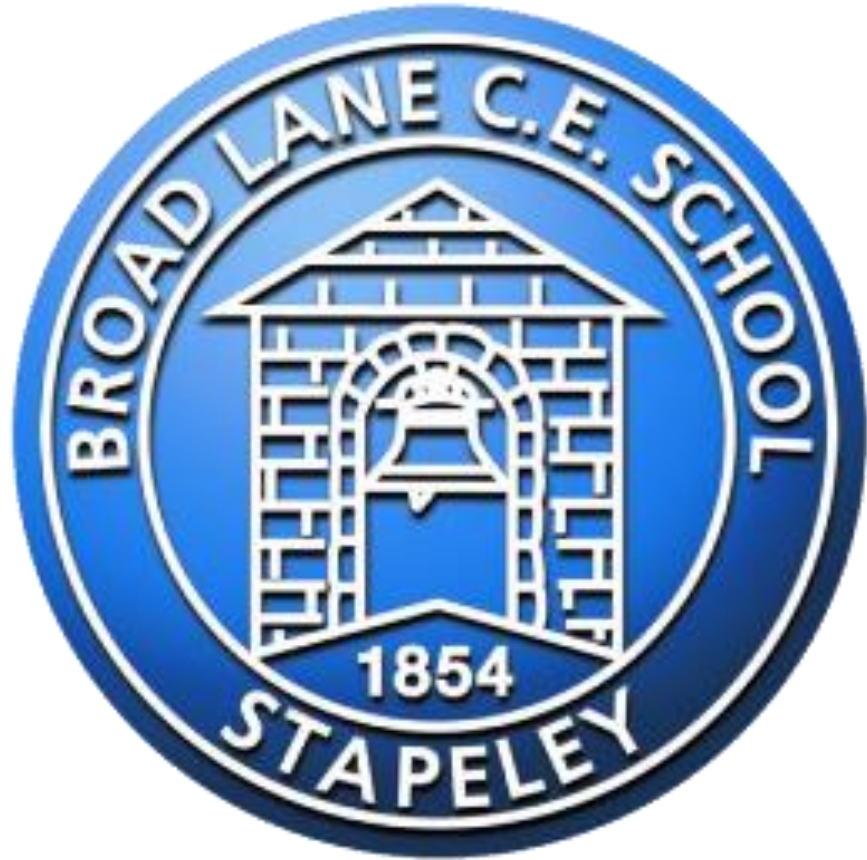

- Playing TTRS rapidly improves recall of times tables - 25% of questions are division questions
- Improving knowledge will increase speed
- Increasing speed allows them to climb up the Rock Superstardom
