## Key Vocabulary

Philosophy - the study of some of the most basic questions about human life

Theology - the study of one or more religions

Human/Social Science - the study of society and the manner in which people behave and influence the world around us

Baptism - a ceremony that symbolises a commitment to living a life as a Christian

Belief - a feeling sure that someone or something exists or is true or trustworthy

Belonging - a person that is part of, or a member of, a group

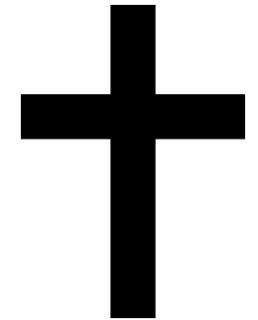
Commitment - to promise to do something and to do it

Faith - trusting in something or someone

Moral - behaviours that can be looked at as right or wrong

Place of Worship - a building where people gather to worship together e.g. church, synagogue, mosque

Trinity - the Christian belief that there is One God, who is the Father, Son and Holy Spirit
