Key Vocabulary

Philosophy - the study of some of the most basic questions about human life

<u>Theology</u> - the study of one or more religions

<u>Human/Social Science</u> - the study of society and the manner in which people behave and influence the world around us

Baptism - a ceremony that symbolises a commitment to living a life as a Christian

Belief - a feeling sure that someone or something exists or is true or trustworthy

Belonging - a person that is part of, or a member of, a group

<u>Commitment -</u> to promise to do something and to do it

<u>Faith</u> - trusting in something or someone

Moral - behaviours that can be looked at as right or wrong

<u>Place of Worship -</u> a building where people gather to worship together e.g. church, synagogue, mosque

<u>Trinity -</u> the Christian belief that there is One God, who is the Father, Son and Holy Spirit
