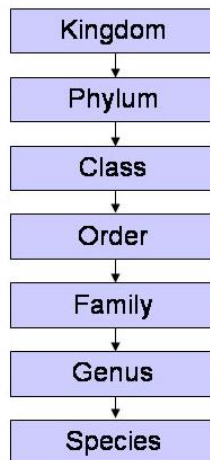

Key vocabulary:

Vertebrate: Animals with backbones

Invertebrate: Animals without a backbone

Crustacean: an arthropod.

Classification: the action or process of classifying something.

Micro-organisms: tiny living things – only seen by microscope.

Fish: Gills, Live in water, lay eggs, cold blooded

Amphibians: Live land or sea, lay eggs, moist skin

Mammals: Give birth to live young, hair/fur, produce milk

Reptiles: cold blooded, live on land, lay eggs

Birds: feathers, warm blooded, lay eggs
