Solubility: a measurement of how much of a substance will dissolve in a given volume of a liquid.

Conductivity: a measure of how materials allow electric currents flow more freely than others.

Evaporation: the process of turning from liquid into vapour.

Filtering: pass (a liquid, gas, light, or sound) through a device to remove unwanted material.

Transparency: the condition of being transparent- see through.

Permeability: the condition of allowing liquids or gases to pass through it.

Solution: a specific type of mixture where one substance is dissolved into another.

evaporation – used for separating a soluble solid and a liquid sieving – used for separating two solids **magnets** — used for separating magnetic and non-magnetic materials

filtration – used for separating a liquid and a solid
