Cookery

couscous- a dish of semolina which is cooked by steaming.

eatwell plate- the main food groups and their recommended proportions for a healthy diet.

consumer- a person who purchases goods.

recyclable- something which can be recycled.

ingredients- the food required for a particular recipe.

packaging- materials used to wrap or protect goods.



Construction

trinket pot - small pot used to hold jewellery, curiosities or other small, precious objects.

They can be made from an assortment of materials.

design criteria- the goals that a project must achieve in order to be successful.

aesthetic- what a product looks like.

annotations- brief, written explanations to describe aspects of the design

coil- rolling out of clay into a long thin sausage-like form that is wound round like a spring.

score and slip- scratching marks on the surface of the clay and then applying a liquid to the scored surface.



Textiles

woven bracelet- a type of bracelet traditionally used to symbolise friendship.

weaving- a technique in which yarn is woven together to make a fabric.

dyes- substances used to colour materials.

knotting- tying together material.

cords- parts of string or rope.

weft and warp- the two functions used in weaving to turn thread or yarn into fabric.
