<p><b>Create a collage inspired by African animals from our Benin topic.</b> Some animals, such as crocodiles and leopards, appear many times in the art of Benin.</p>	<p><b>How much sugar is in your breakfast cereal or snacks?</b> Carry out an investigation and record your results. How will this affect your teeth?</p>	<p><b>Design your own 'mindful colouring' sheet inspired by our Benin topic.</b> Think about how you might create a detailed design that will take a lot of time and effort to colour in!</p>
<p><b>Create a poster about the importance of cleaning your teeth and how important our teeth are.</b> Remember to use images and colours to make it pop out on the page!</p>	<p><b>Design a maths board game using times tables and division facts.</b> Could you design the playing board, pieces and counters? Don't forget to write the rules!</p>	<p><b>Research the main factors that affect our mental well-being and give advice on how we can combat this.</b> You can present this in any way e.g. poster, PowerPoint presentation, leaflet.</p>
<p><b>Pick a free reader book from the library. Design your own front cover and write your own blurb to go on the back.</b> Make sure your blurb persuades your reader to pick up the book!</p>	<p><b>Create a map of your local area.</b> What human and physical geography can you see? Has this changed over time?</p>	<p><b>Create a poster or model about the digestive system.</b> Make your poster or model as eye-catching as you can!</p>
